

High Demand Prompts Construction of Second Corporate FBO Hangar at Houston Executive Airport

BROOKSHIRE -- (January 25, 2010) – Due to high demand for corporate leasing space, Houston Executive Airport (KTME) has completed construction of a second corporate FBO hangar.

Completion of the 23,400 square-foot-hangar follows construction of a 26,000 square-foot-hangar which opened in 2009. HEA opened 20 T-Hangars in 2007 which are all currently leased. This brings total leased space to over 71,000 square feet.
